Terms and Conditions

The purpose of the Zaki Badr Foundation Islamic Education Scholarship is to assist needy students attending Islamic Schools who demonstrate strong academic promise. Students must meet the following guidelines:

1. Students must be in grade 1-12 and enrolled in a full-time Islamic School;
2. Islamic studies must be a required part of the student's course of study; (Schools with more developed Islamic studies programs will be favored.)
3. Student's family must have applied and qualified for financial aid at the student's Islamic School; applicants who qualified but did not receive financial aid at the local level due to a lack of local funds may still apply; (Students shown to be in greater financial need will be favored.)
4. Student must have maintained a 3.0 GPA for each grading period of the previous academic year; (Student's with higher GPA's will be favored.)
5. Student must be able to demonstrate a preference for Islamic education and a love for Islam as a way of life by submitting an essay (or drawing for grades 1-2 only) in this regard with their application; [Essay should be no longer than 2 pages max.]

Rules for scholarship awards:

1. Scholarship will be payable to the institution for the amount of the school's annual book and supply fee, not to exceed \$350;
2. Scholarship is good only for the academic year in which it is awarded;
3. Recipients will be chosen at the discretion of the Zaki Badr Foundation upon verification of criteria and evaluation of applications;
4. All applications must be received by June 30th;
5. Applications will be considered in order of receipt; Applications received earliest will be favored over those that come later;
6. Scholarships will be awarded on or before August 1st; Recipients will be notified of award by mail;
7. Recipient's names will not be published, but the name of the schools awarded scholarships may be posted on the Foundation's website and/or other literature promoting the Foundation's goals and objectives;
8. The Zaki Badr Foundation reserves the right to anonymously publish essays and drawings submitted by applicants on the Foundation's website and and/or other literature promoting the Foundation's goals and objectives;
9. The number of scholarships to be awarded may vary according to availability of funds and financial support for the Zaki Badr Scholarship fund.
